



## **DIVERSITY PROFILE**

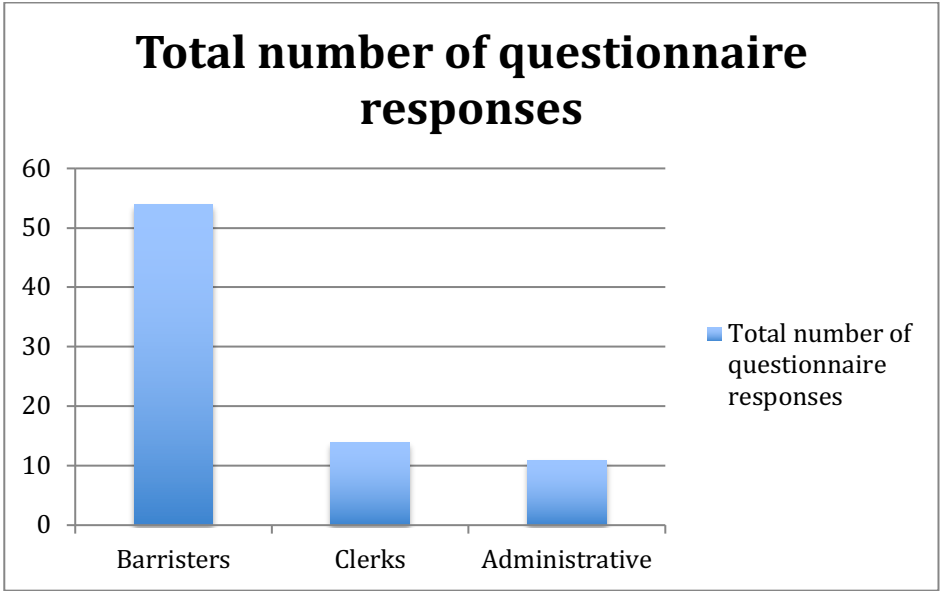

Participation in the survey was optional. The results below reflect the diversity profile of the volunteers only.

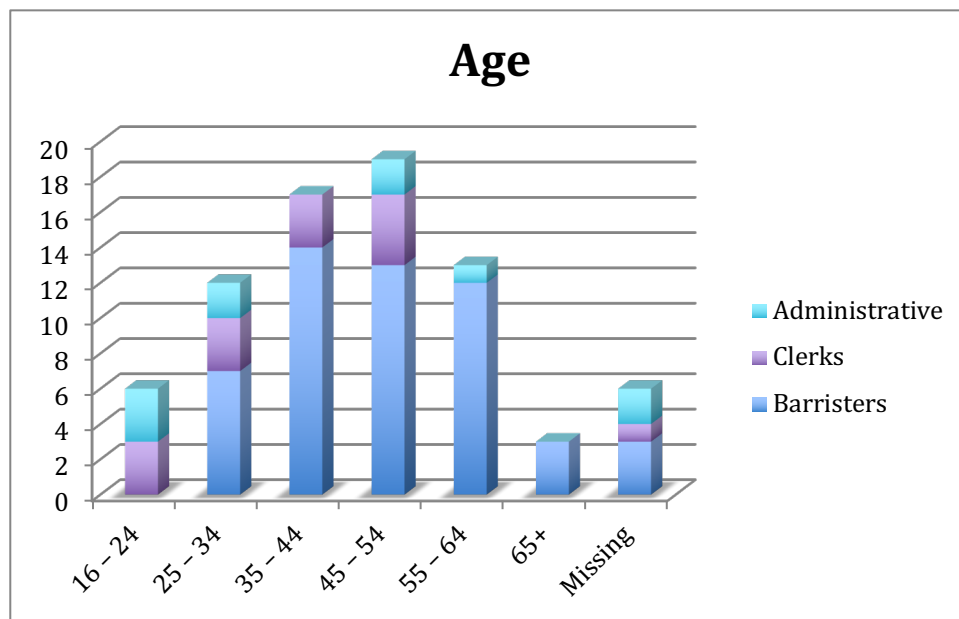
### **Missing data**

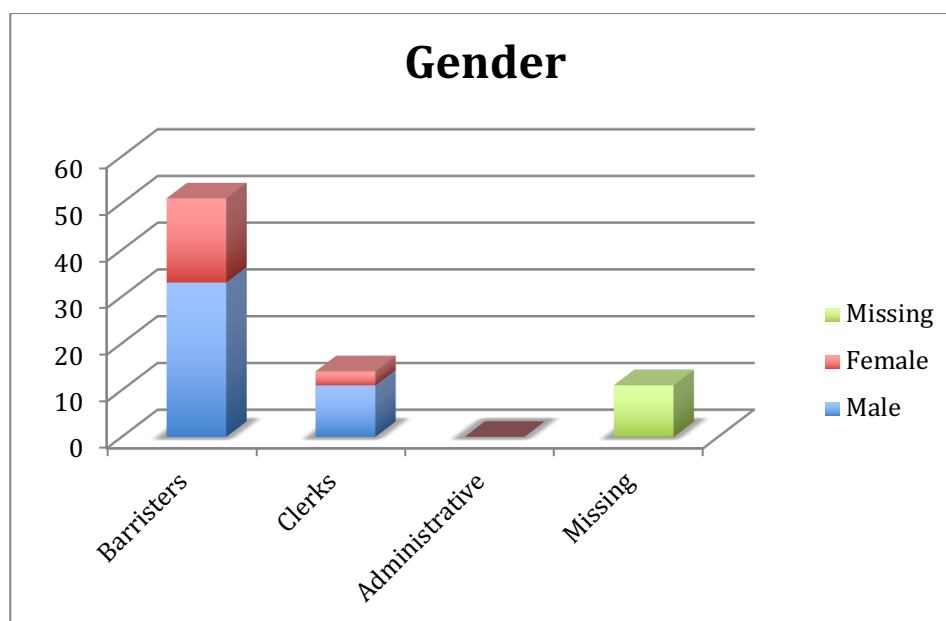
Total number of responses to the survey



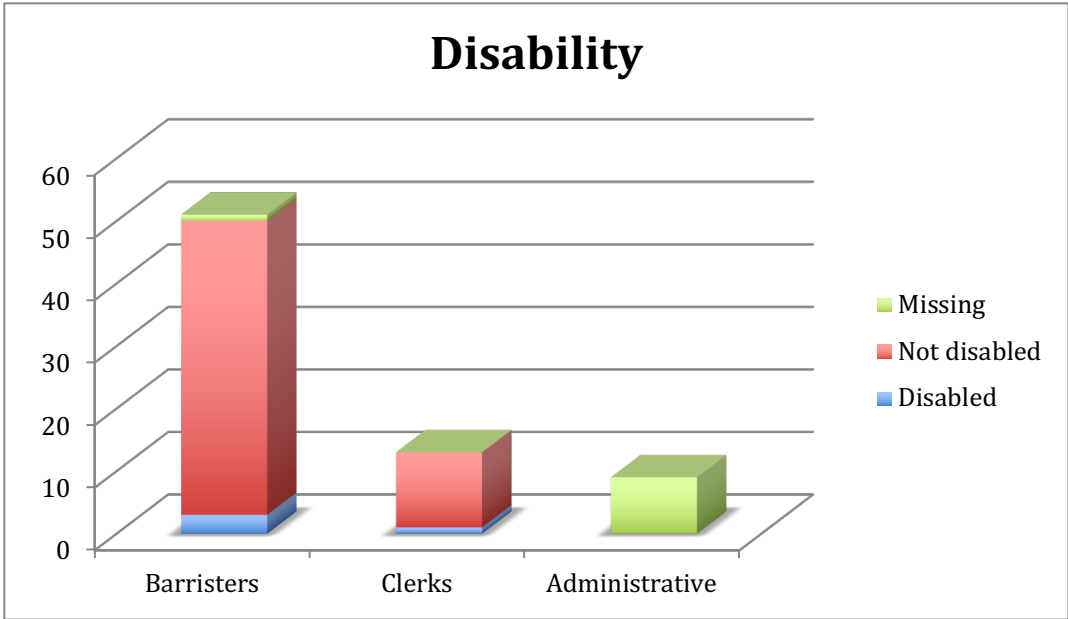

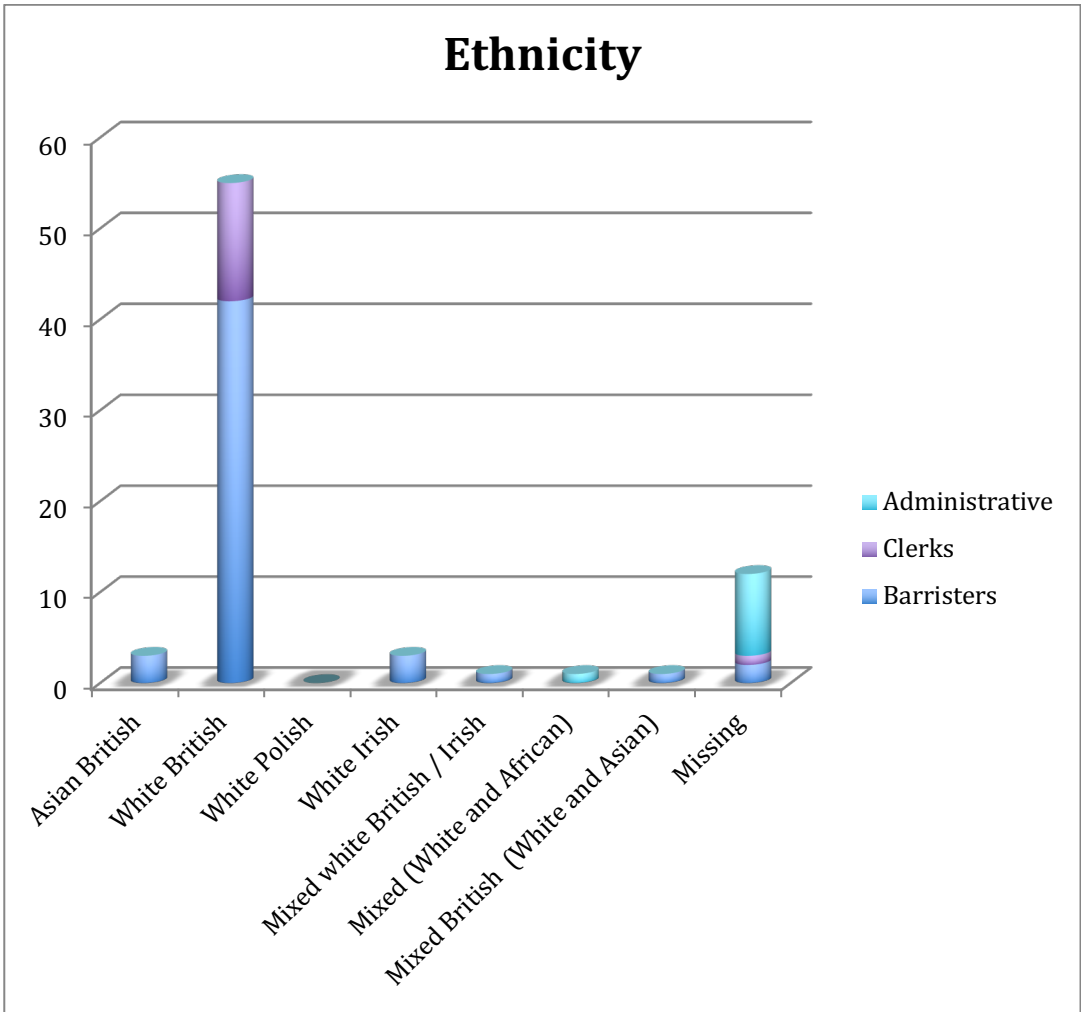

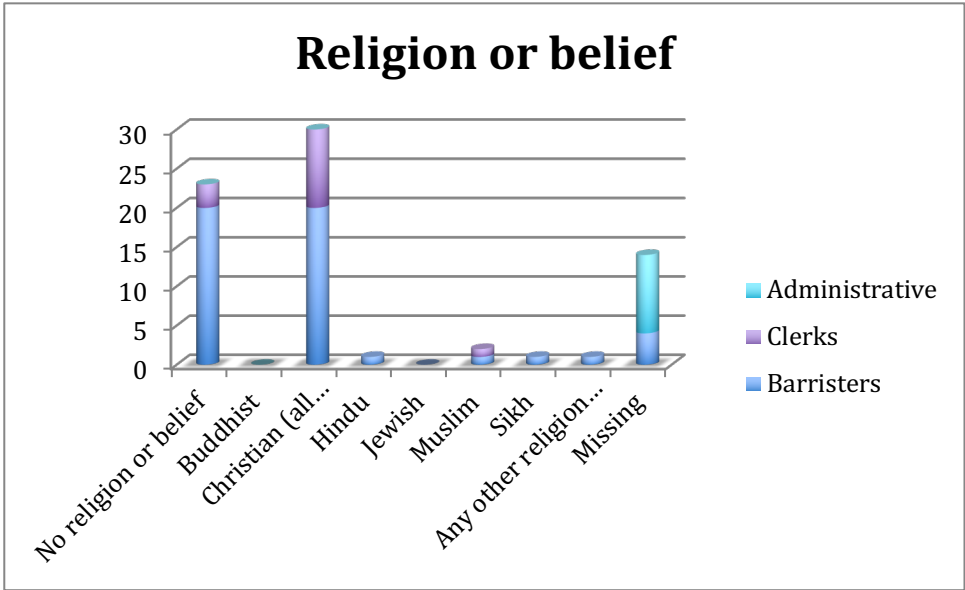

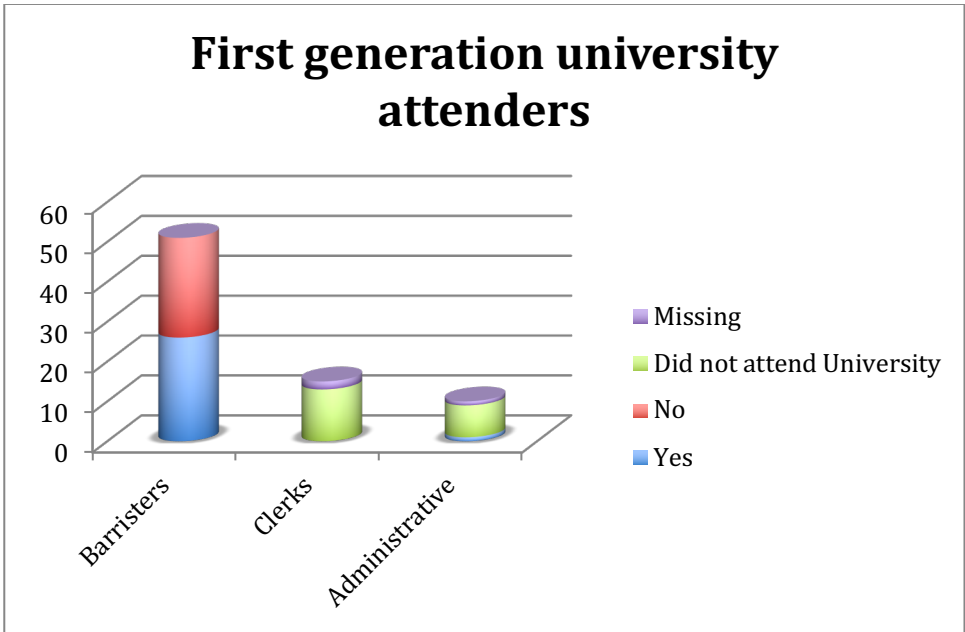

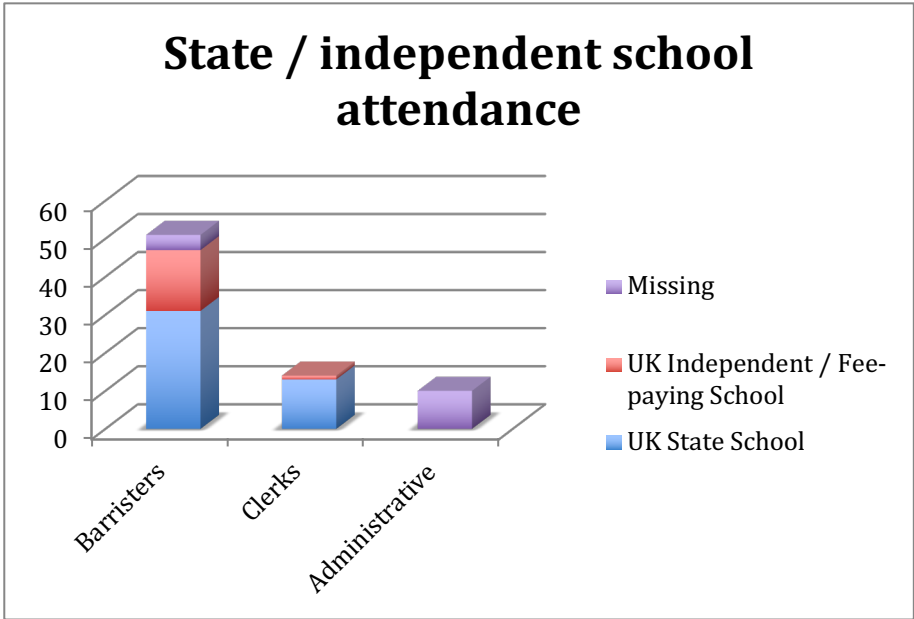

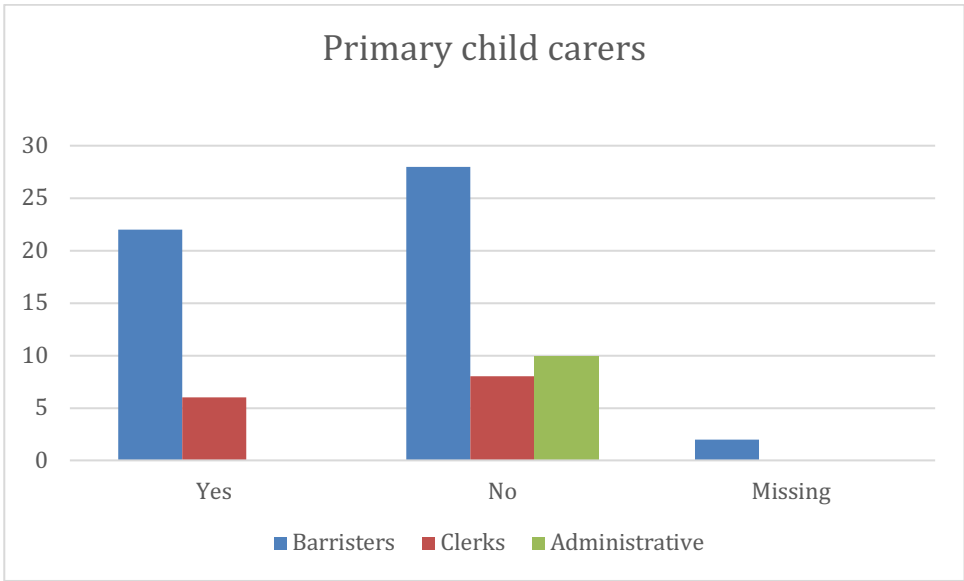
